

# CMA UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS FOR REGIONAL YOUTH

EVERY YEAR, THE FOUNDATION OF THE QUEBEC CMA ORDER OFFERS FIVE \$2,000 SCHOLARSHIPS TO CANDIDATES TO THE CERTIFIED MANAGEMENT ACCOUNTANT DESIGNATION (CMA) WHO WILL PRACTICE THE PROFESSION AND BECOME INVOLVED IN THE COMMUNITY IN REGIONAL AREAS.

## Objectives

In partnership with *Place aux jeunes en région*, the Foundation's objectives are to encourage younger generations to stay or settle in regional areas suffering from an exodus of young people and get them to become involved in the community.

## Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for a scholarship, the student must:

- » be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident and 35 years old or younger;
- » have successfully completed an undergraduate program in management or accountancy and be taking steps on the path leading to the CMA designation;
- » agree to reside and practice his or her profession in a region targeted by the *Place aux jeunes en région* program;
- » become involved in the community (i.e. socially, politically or in education, etc.).

## Application

The application file is composed of a document of a maximum of three pages in length, in which applicants describe the reasons why they want to settle or stay in a regional area to pursue their career. In addition, applicants must describe their current activities in the community (i.e. socially, politically or in education, etc.) and explain how they intend to get involved in the community in the coming years. The quality of the presentation will also be considered by the selection committee.
